## Five who used counterfeit bills may be in ring

SAN ANTONIO — Authorities say five people indicted on charges of passing counterfeit \$100 bills may be part of a nationwide counterfeiting ring operating out of Houston and Detroit.

About \$11,000 in fake money has been found in the San Antonio area, and more is believed to exist, federal investigators said Tuesday.

One of the five indicted was accused of selling phony \$100 bills for \$30, but none of the five apparently participated in printing the money, said Barney Boyett, agent in charge of the Secret Service in San Antonio. The bills are printed so well that only a currency expert could tell they are not real, he said.

An investigation began in 1975 when a woman was arrested and charged with trying to pass one of the counterfeit bills. The local discounter, and the Service agents confiscated counterfeit bills at a San Antonio residence, Boyett said.

The investigation will continue, Boyett said investigators believe a counterfeiting operation may be operating in Houston and Detroit.

Those charged are Leonard Grant, 27; Leonard Hill, 23; Ernest Ruiz, 21; Allen Woods, 27, and Bright Jones, 32, all of San Antonio.

## Chagra requests change of venue

SAN ANTONIO — El Paso drug smuggler Jimmy Chagra asked Wednesday that his trial in the 1979 slaying of federal Judge John H. Wood be moved somewhere outside of Texas.

In a motion filed in federal court, Chagra's attorney said it would be impossible to get a fair jury because of "hostile sentiment in the community."

The motion continued: "It is suggested that because the publicity has been so great and so diverse and has created such a bad image of Mr. Chagra that a change of venue is warranted even before the court attempts to seat a jury."

Wood was gunned down outside his San Antonio apartment on the day that Chagra was tried in his court martial charges under the federal Espionage Act. He was later convicted and sentenced in another court to life in prison.

Chagra, his wife, Elizabeth, and his brother, Joe, have been indicted in Wood's death along with convicted hit man Charles Harrelson and his wife, Jane. The motion filed today requested "extensive publicity spreading on the nature of the indictment and on the indictment itself being generated in all media lets through the state."

Attorney Oscar Gooden said he would submit evidence of the "magnitude of pre-publicity" dating back to Wood's death.

## Foods may help prevent cancer

MINNEAPOLIS — Developing a taste for foods such as cabbage, black tea, broccoli and cauliflower may help protect you against cancer, medical researchers say.

Dr. Lee Wattenberg, a University of Minnesota professor, says researchers have discovered that chemicals in foods such as cabbage, coffee beans, Brussels sprouts, orange oil, cauliflower, broccoli and black tea have cancer-protection potential.

Wattenberg recently received a \$1 million research grant from the American Cancer Society to pursue the possibilities of developing the preventatives.

Wattenberg said he would like to see his research results the concentration of what cancer-protective chemicals found in these foods and enter the foods or put them in form.

Wattenberg said a long study of 1,954 Chicago found less risk of lung cancer even among smokers, in those who consumed large amounts of carrots, spinach and other vegetables containing the chemical beta-carotene.

Wattenberg said, however, the number of cancer cases small and there is no way to ensure other factors are not involved.
