1,200 activists blockade nuclear weapons lab

HELENA, Mont. — The late Gen. Douglas MacArthur was accused Saturday of collaborating with a Japanese general to obtain still-secret records on American prisoners of war used as biological warfare guinea pigs during World War II.

The accusation was made in testimony at a hearing before the U.S. House Committee on Veterans' Affairs.

American GIs, captured by the Japanese in the Philippines in 1942, were transported to a

Japanese POW camp in Mukden, Manchuria, where the experiments were conducted, said Greg Rodriguez Jr., of Missoula, Mont., chairman of an organization called Ex-POW Vision Quest.

His father is one of the 4,000 Americans still alive who spent time in Japanese POW camps during World War II.

Rodriguez and others appealed to the committee for help in obtaining better health treatment and compensation for those ex-POWs. They charged

McArthur had obtained the records for military purposes — exchange for keeping information of the experiments secret — prevent Ishii from being tried as a war criminal.

As a result, Rodriguez and others charged, potentially medical information contained in those records has been withheld from former prisoners ejected to the Japanese experiments.

"Gen. Douglas A. MacArthur left his men in 1942 and promised the war criminal Gen. Ishii, immunity from prosecution if he would surrender the records of Unit 731," Rodriguez testified.

"This collaboration between MacArthur and Ishii is unacceptable," Rodriguez said.

Rodriguez called it a "culpable conspiracy: an American holocaust."

Unit 731 of the Japanese Army has been identified as an ultra-secret biological warfare unit headquartered at Pingping Manchuria. It had been working on bacteriological weapons, conducting living body tests on Chinese and Russian POWs prior to World War II, according to a recent Tokyo Broadcasting System news document.
