Shuttle's flight begins Sunday

CAPE CANAVERAL, Fla. — Space technicians worked around the clock Tuesday finishing last-minute preparations to start the countdown for the space shuttle Columbia's fourth and final test mission Sunday.

Ground crews expected to finish work on the orbiter and solid-rocket boosters for the 90-hour countdown expected to

start Tuesday.

Astronauts Thomas "Ken" Mattingly and Henry W. Hartfield are scheduled to blast off at 11 a.m. EDT Sunday and land a week later — on the Fourth of July — in California's Mojave Desert. President Reagan is expected to be on hand to welcome them home.

"We had a slight problem with a ground power supply last Friday and that delayed countdown preps about a day," said space agency spokeswoman Leslie Vock. "But the power unit has been replaced, we have made up the lost time and we are back on schedule. Everything seems to be just clicking along."

The countdown includes 90 hours of scheduled work and 24 hours of built-in "hold" time, which can be used to make up lagging work or to give the ground crew some time off.

Previous countdowns have lasted 73 hours and have included about 30 hours of holds.

Seized cocaine worth \$34 million

SANTA FE, N.M. — More than 200 pounds of Colombian cocaine were seized and three men were arrested in what offi-

cial say was the largest cocaine bust in the Southwest.

The three suspects were charged with criminal trespass following their arrest Monday near a Santa Rosa, N.M. ranch. Authorities earlier in the month conducted the raid and netted 214 pounds of cocaine worth an estimated \$34 million.

Police investigator Richard deBaca said the three suspects were identified as Jose Garcia of Vilatis, Mexico; and Jose Mauricio Rico, both Colombian with Florida addresses.

DeBaca said the cocaine was found on the ranch June 7 and the owner had reported suspicious activity to police.

It was dropped the night before from a plane, he said.

Four people were arrested the time of the drop, including two pilots, he said. Only one, an unidentified Colombian, was charged as an alien.

"New Mexico, due to its sparse population and isolation is a popular state for clandestine airstrips," deBaca said. "There has been a lot of cocaine and marijuana activity in the Santa Fe area."
