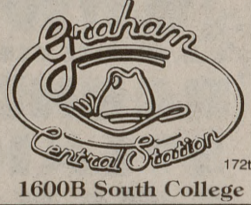

## Patient evaluation by outside doctor ordered by judge

DALLAS — A probate judge says he will appoint two psychiatrists not employed by the Texas Department of Mental Health and Mental Retardation to evaluate a man released recently from jail even though he had confessed to killing a fellow patient at the Terrell State Hospital.  
Judge Joseph E. Ashmore Monday ordered Christopher C. Nalley, 20, transferred from the Hillside Mental Diagnostic Center in Dallas back to Terrell State Hospital. The judge signed an order putting Nalley under protective custody for up to 14 days.  
"He's there because we want to be sure of what his present mental status is," Ashmore said. "If he needs to be in a mental hospital, that is where he should be."  
Nalley was released from jail July 1 after state District Judge Richard Davis of Kaufman County ruled police had illegally obtained his confession in the 1978 slaying of a Grand Prairie boy, 13, who was a patient with Nalley at Terrell.  
Nalley had been committed indefinitely to Terrell in 1977 after being found mentally incompetent to stand trial.

After the death of the Prairie boy, state officials ruled he was psychotic and returned to jail in Kaufman, where he spent the past 3 1/2 years. In an affidavit filed Monday, Hillside psychiatrist Harrington diagnosed Nalley as suffering from organic brain disease, a mental disorder by physical damage to the brain.  
Tom S. McCorkle, an attorney, said he supervised the evaluation of his client at the psychiatric hospital. "I do not have much experience in MH-MR personnel (who are) large and competent," Dr. J.R. Clemons, the superintendent of the Terrell State Hospital, said he had no problem with the judge consulting with psychiatrists but said Terrell doctors are as competent as those anywhere.
