## Oilman's widow sues ex-partner

**DALLAS**— Trial resumed today in the \$1 billion lawsuit by the widow of oil millionaire W.W. Browning Jr. against his lifelong friend and business partner, Pat Holloway.

Jane Browning contends Holloway swindled her and her five children out of millions she and her husband made in Humble Exploration Co., which successfully penetrated the Austin Chalk fields near Giddings in the early 1970s.  
Holloway counters that the Brownings are engaging in a "brazon conspiracy" to seize the business he built.  
Browning, who received a \$400,000-a-month inheritance from his mother's oil wealth, formed the company as a tax shelter in 1974 with Holloway, who had attended high school and Yale University with Browning and was Browning's attorney, Mrs. Browning testified last week.

Browning died of a heart attack in 1976, and Mrs. Browning left Holloway in charge of her husband's business holdings until 1978, when she asked him

when she would see a return on her husband's \$4 million investments in the oil venture.  
"Well, out of the blue he immediately blew up and told me it was stupid if I thought for one minute he was working for me," she testified. "Humble was his thing but not mine. I was a thing but Bill's dirty whore. My children were just dumb and stupid and I could just forget the whole thing."  
Holloway told her he owned 80 percent of Humble, and she and vice president Michael Starnes owned 10 percent each, she said.

She testified Holloway threatened he would "destroy them completely" if they did not transfer their stock to him. Holloway and Mrs. Browning negotiated a \$15 million settlement three years ago, but when Holloway failed to meet a \$2 million initial payment, Mrs. Browning returned to court to enforce the agreement.  
Holloway then filed bankruptcy papers. Humble Exploration has been reorganized and has resumed operations.

## Execution-style deaths investigated

**RICHMOND**— A medical examiner Monday ruled that four men who were found in thick brush on the banks of the Brazos River in Fort Bend County died of gunshot wounds to the head.  
Authorities continued to investigate the possibility that the deaths were linked to the deaths of two unidentified Hispanic men found early Sunday by a Santa Fe Railroad crew near Pearland in Brazoria County.

The bodies of the two were lying side by side, one face up and the other face down, Brazoria County Sheriff's Capt. Barney Woodard said. The hands on both men were tied behind their backs.  
"This looks like the same deal

as in Fort Bend County, Woodard said.  
The decomposed bodies of the other four men were found by game wardens on a Brazos River bank late Friday afternoon.  
Those bodies also were found side by side, two face up and two face down. The hands of one of the men was tied with a rope.  
"There is nothing definitive yet, but there are some similarities," Fort Bend County Sheriff Ervis Hurta said. "We're working with the Brazoria County sheriff's office."

The four men were identified by the Harris County Medical Examiner Monday as Jose Garman, 25; Misael Turcio, 17; Roman Turcio, 16, and Pablo Parices, 19, all from "somewhere in Mexico."

## Kidnapped woman rescued

**DALLAS**— Police today were holding a man, 23, captured in the dramatic rescue of a kidnapped victim from the trunk of a car the suspect was driving.

Police spokesman Bob Sharp said the woman was released after a patrolman stopped the car on a routine check at 1:30 a.m. Sunday, and heard a someone banging on the inside of the trunk.  
A second suspect fled the scene.

Investigators noted similarities between Sunday's incident and the kidnapping last week of a woman who was raped and terrorized for three and a half hours before escaping, Sharp said.

Shaw said two men were spotted sitting in a parked car by officer Thomas Ward, who pulled up to investigate. The car drove away, but Ward stopped a few blocks away, and as he radioed for assistance he heard a thumping sound coming from the trunk.
