# Scholars publish new translation of Hebrew Bible

After 25 years, a committee of Jewish scholars has completed work on a new translation of the Hebrew Scriptures — the first vernacular and modern translation of the Bible for Jews in 2,300 years.

The third and final volume of the project — The Writings, or, in Hebrew, Kethubim — has just been released by the Jewish Publication Society of America. The society earlier published The Torah, the first five books of the Bible, and later, The Prophets.

The Writings contains the books of Psalms, Proverbs, Job, The Song of Songs, Ruth, Lamentations, Ecclesiastes, Esther, Daniel, Ezra, Nehemiah, and I and II Chronicles.

Among those contributing to the new translation was Chaim Potok, the best-selling Jewish novelist, who served for 16 years as secretary and project coordinator of the committee and unofficially acted as arbitrator in manners of style.

Professors Nahum Sarna of Brandeis University and Moshe

Greenberg and Jonas Greenfield, both of Hebrew University in Israel, were the biblical scholars charged with the new translation.

Sarna describes the new as "the first translation of the Masoretic (original Hebrew) text into the vernacular by an organized committee of Jewish scholars since the Septuagint translation of the Bible into Greek completed in Alexandria during the third century before the Common Era (B.C.)."

Professor Harry Orlinsky, who first proposed the new project 29 years ago, called the completed three-volume version "the greatest scholarly work in the history of the Jewish community of America in the 20th century."

But it is not without its own dimensions as well.

"So pervasive has been the impact of this translation that both testant and Catholics are reading their Bible in accordance with the philosophy of our Jewish translation," Orlinsky says.

Orlinsky, a major contributor to the first volume of the Bible, the Torah translation published in 1963, was also only non-Protestant to serve the committee of 22 scholars who prepared the Revised Standard Version of Bible published by the National Council of Churches. That version is currently recognized among Christian scholars as the most scholarly and authoritative translation.

A preface to the new volume underscores the ecumenical context of the translation:

"The entire gamut of biblical interpretation, ancient and modern, Jewish and Christian, are likely to find strange and perhaps unsettling renderings of familiar passages. The famous opening line, Ecclesiastes, for example, 'Vanity of vanity. All is vanity' translated in 'The Writings' as 'Utter futility. All is futility.' Sarna admits it is a less literal translation but insists it is a rendering of the author's intention.

And in the 23rd Psalm — one of the most familiar of all biblical passages — the phrase 'valley of the shadow of death' is translated as 'valley of deep darkness.'

The scholars said they sought to convey "something of the rectness, the simplicity and uniquely Israelite expressiveness that are so essential to the sublimity of the Hebrew Bible."
