Nashville integration plan rejected by court

CINCINNATI — A federal appeals court Tuesday rejected a controversial student assignment plan designed to put an end to segregated schools in Nashville, Tenn., and surrounding Davidson County.

The 6th U.S. Circuit Court of Appeals, in a 2-1 decision, said the plan did not sufficiently improve racial balance in the county-wide district to meet constitutional standards for desegregation.

Appellate Court Judges George C. Edwards and Nathaniel Jones said the plan designed by Nashville U.S. District Court Judge Thomas Wiseman left elementary schools in the 67,000-student system "highly segregated," and did not adequately integrate high schools and middle schools.

The majority judge suggested Wiseman was concerned with "white flight" and pressure on neighborhood schools. The district judge's decision accepted a 15 percent minority either race in middle schools.

"This figure is clearly acceptable as a starting point for a school system that has a 49 percent white/32 percent black composition," the court majority said.

The majority judge said the plan violated the constitution. Wiseman's desegregation order, the majority judge said, "would serve to segregate or to maintain segregation in grades K-4."

They added: "Forty-seven of the 75 elementary schools are more than 90 percent white, with 14 schools more than three-quarters black."

Barclay's Bank International Ltd. of London charged in lawsuit filed in federal court that the defendants caused the bank to loan \$750 million to a now-bankrupt steel fabricating company which diversified into coal mining interests.

Defendants in the suit include Jack C. Massey of Nashville, chairman of Massey Burns Investments Inc.; Insurance Commissioner John C. Neff of Nashville; and R. Joseph Robinson of Bristol, Tenn., who was president of the bankrupt company.

Massey, speaking for the tire group, said in a press release Monday that "Although we have not seen final charges filed by the plaintiff, we have been informed of the general nature of the complaint and it is totally unfounded."

The London-based bank said the defendants were officers and directors of a Tennessee steel fabricating firm now bankrupt called Enterprise Fabricators Inc., and that bank was induced to issue a loan based on financial information that the defendants knew was false.

Why do fish have scales? Mammals' skin, scales protect fish against disease and infection. Yet scales also serve as camouflage. The iridescent-looking scales on a fish's body can reflect and refract light, making a swimming predator look upward, the gleaming underside of a potential prey is hard to distinguish from the bright, mirror-like under surface of the water. Scales are also believed by some scientists to reduce friction, but others think big scales make a fish less flexible, inhibiting mobility. In either case, like tree trunks, fish scales have annual rings which are believed to correspond to the passage of winter. By counting the rings, biologists can determine a fish's age.
