Nashville integration plan rejected by cour

CINCINNATI — A federal
appeals court Tuesday rejected a controversial student assignment plan designed to put an end to segregated schools in Nashville, Tenn., and surround-ing Davidson County.

The 6th U.S. Circuit Court of Appeals, in a 2-1 decision, said the plan did not sufficiently improve racial balance in the county-wide district to meet constitutional standards for desegrega-

Appellate Court Judges George C. Edwards and Nathaniel Jones said the plan designed by Nashville U.S. District Court Judge Thomas Wiseman left elementary schools in the 67,000-student system "highly segregated," and did not adequately integrate high schools and middle schools.
