"My wife said, 'It's coming right now,'" he said. "I looked down and there it was."

The mother, Andrea Mann, 29, was sitting upright in the car, Mann said.

"The baby came right out and (my wife) caught her before she hit the floorboard," he said.

Michelle weighed 6 pounds, 2 ounces. Officials at St. Francis Hospital in Blue Island, Ill., said Sunday both mother and daughter were fine.

The Manns said they waited until the last minute Friday to drive the 3 miles to the hospital because the baby was not due until Aug. 24.

Buckingham Palace told London Sun Sunday Prince Charles was "very conscious of his role as president of the British Medical Association and wanted to "set an example."

Charles's donor card allows physicians to remove his liver and kidneys for transplants.

"The prince takes a very keen interest in medical advancement and his love for people is well known," said a spokesman at Buckingham Palace.
