## Balanced budget 'unlikely' FACKI

United Press International WASHINGTON — Balancing the federal budget is not a realistic possibility in the next three years, the Congressional Budget Office says, predicting deficits averaging \$155 billion unless Congress acts quickly.

More taxes will have to be imposed and further cuts, including some in defense and Social Security, will have to be made to lower the deficit, the

budget review, the CBO pre-dicted the deficit will climb from \$112 billion in fiscal 1982 to \$155 billion next year, even if Congress enacts the remaining spending cuts called for in the 1983 budget resolution.

Congress already has made \$30 billion in spending cuts and has hiked taxes \$98.3 billion. Federal deficits are projected in 1984 and 1985.
