### New mountain mosaic to dwarf Rushmore

GRANITE, Okla. — The famous presidents carved in Mount Rushmore in the Black Hills of South Dakota may soon be dwarfed by a granite monument nearly twice as tall.

The granite carvings of George Washington, Abraham Lincoln, Thomas Jefferson and Teddy Roosevelt, known worldwide as Mount Rushmore, stand

The mosaic of Will Rogers, Jim Thorpe and Sequoyah planned for the mountains overlooking Granite will be 116 feet high, said monument carver Bill

The Oklahoma project, entitled "Giants of the Great Plains," temporarily has been placed on hold while Willis, 58, tries to soli-cit hundreds of thousands of dollars to complete the monu-

Willis began carving and assembling Rogers' portrait in 1979 and unveiled the 28-footmosaic bust, containing the humorist's head and shoulders, during ceremonies on the 100th anniversary of Rogers' birthday

in November 1979. Willis said he spent \$20,000 of his own money and \$30,000 in contributions to complete the bust and will need an additional \$300,000 to complete the Rogers portrait and put it on the

The entire project, including all three figures, will cost more than \$1 million, he said.

Much of the cost will be leveling off the mountain and building an elaborate wind-resistant steel frame to support the mosaic, which eventually will incorporate all three figures.
Willis, who studied architec-

ture but has made his living producing granite tombstones and historical monuments, based his design on paintings of the three Oklahomans in the state Capitol. He said he chose Rogers, famed athlete Thorpe and Sequoyah, the chief who invented the Cherokee alphabet, because of their apolitical image and In-




