Children grieve as hospital error

SALINAS, Calif. — For three agonizing hours Phyllis Gibbs' children thought their mother had died in a Caldwell, Idaho, hospital.

Then they learned it was a mistake. A patient with the same last name had died from heart problems, but Mrs. Gibbs was fine.

"We felt two different emotions in one day — the two most powerful emotions anyone can feel," Kimberly Gibbs, 19, said Monday from the family's Salinas home. "We were hysterical. It was so terrible. I couldn't sleep last night."

She said the family had informed relatives in Arkansas and they were planning to come west to attend the funeral.

"My grandmother had given oxygen when she out," Miss Gibbs said. "We called the hospital three times and begged them to tell us, 'Say it isn't true three times they told us.' Then we came to find out hours later my mother was dead. It was a mix-up."

"Another woman with the same name and number (hospital tag) had died," Gibbs explained.

The confusion began Monday when Miss Gibbs' grandparents in Caldwell, Idaho, where her mother was visiting, to confirm with Gibbs would be returning to California.

Her grandparents told Mrs. Gibbs had suffered a stroke but told her not to worry she was OK and in the hospital. Debbie Lebaudour, Gibbs' oldest daughter, called to phone Caldwell Memorial Hospital to question officials out their mother's condition.

The family was swayed by the intensive-care unit Mrs. Gibbs had just died. "We were all screaming, 'It was a mix-up. My little brother was losing his mind. My mother was hysterical,'" Miss Gibbs said.


A spokeswoman at the well hospital said the error occurred when the name call was switched to the care where doctors were ing on a patient with the problems. That patient's name named Gibbs, but had a different first name.

Officials assumed they were talking to the family of the patient so they inadvertently gave the wrong information, a spokeswoman said.

She said it was a "code" emergency when the hospital was so busy, you're trying to get a patient. These things do happen to and we're very sorry. As far as we could, we rectified it as quickly as possible."

The family said an aunt and uncle also were mistakenly told Mrs. Gibbs was dead. Her brothers and sister have since been cleared up.

"She's feeling OK. It was a very much to know what had gone through. But she needs her rest and she's home."
