Parole hearing set for Ruiz

AUSTIN — The Texas parole board is scheduled to open hearings Sept. 20 to decide whether the parole of prison activist David Ruiz should be revoked, despite his acquittal last week of robbery charges.

Board members voted 2-1 Tuesday to direct their hearing examiner to review the evidence in the November 1981 robbery of an Austin nightspot, and recommend whether Ruiz should be returned to prison.

Ruiz, 40, was paroled in June 1981 after serving 12 years of a 25-year robbery sentence. If his parole is revoked, he would face another 13 years in prison.

Ruiz successfully sued the state Department of Corrections in federal court over inmate living conditions while he was in prison.

During his nearly month-long trial on the Austin robbery charge, Ruiz claimed he was a victim of a conspiracy by TDC because of his role as an inmate advocate.

Parole board attorney Chuck Walker said the panel's vote is not "an indication of the way the board feels about this."

"They certainly have not made up their minds that David Ruiz is guilty," he said.

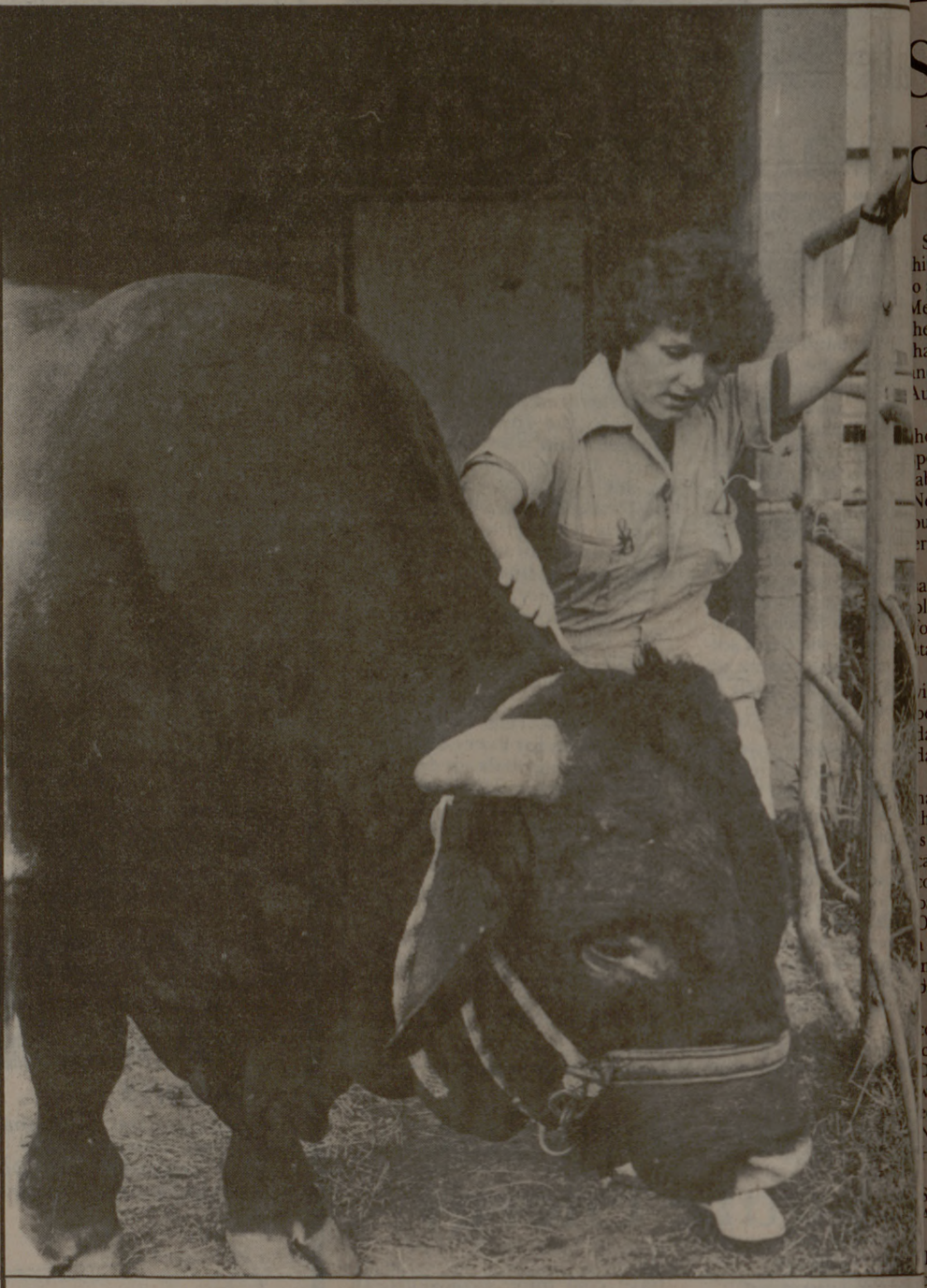

Damage caused by arson

JONESTOWN — Arson suspected in a forest fire that destroyed more than 200 acres along the lake peninsula of Lake Travis.

Fire officials said arson apparently used several made parachutes attached to flares to ignite the dry brush along the lake peninsula northwest of Austin.

"Those parachutes had intricate stitching," said Clive Powers, a Jones town fireman who was one of the first firefighters to arrive at the blaze. "Some one went through a lot of trouble to do this."

More than 70 volunteers from 11 districts battled the fire Tuesday and Monday and the Texas Forest Service arrived Tuesday to continue the effort, extinguishing the fire.
