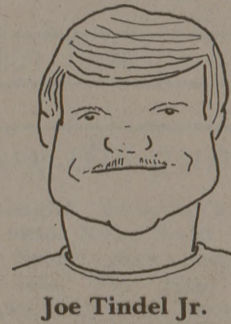

pleting 23 of 43 passes for 260 yards, while Hector led all Aggie rushers with 52 yards. Thomas Sanders contributed 44 yards to Texas A&M's 162-yard rushing effort.

And the Mavs know all about the changes Sherrill and his staff have made in the Aggie offense and defense during the past two weeks. Senior Paul Pender has taken Jon van Sant's spot at left defensive end, while Fred Caldwell will start in place of Keith Guthrie at left tackle.

Strong safety Jeff Fuller has moved up to strong-side linebacker, while sophomore Rusty Nettles will be the weak-side linebacker. Junior Jerry Bullitt will occupy the middle linebacker's seater position.

Freshman free safety Domingo Bryant will join Smith as the Aggies' two starting freshmen in Saturday's game, while Billy Cannon moves in a few steps from free safety as the starter at strong safety.

"I feel like Billy Cannon is a very impressive defensive player and he gets around the field very well," Elliott said. "We know Bryant must be a good player if he's beaten all those other players out to start."

During Monday's weekly press conference, Sherrill said the defensive changes might not last through the week, depending upon the team's workouts. However, he said Thursday that the Aggies will start the UTA game with all of the changes intact.

Elliott's two quarterbacks, starter Kraig Hopkins and second-stringer Danny Jackson, will share playing time Saturday, Elliott said. In the defeat of SHSU, Jackson threw three touchdown passes and Hopkins

threw one as the two combined for 251 passing yards — on only seven completions.

Since Boston College exploited Aggie secondary on several deep routes, it's probable the Mavs will do the same. And Bryant, the Aggies' new deep safety, will have to stay on his toes.

"I'm just going to get in there and do my best, which is all you can ask of anyone," Bryant said. Bryant, who says good range is his strong suit, describes the Aggies' team outlook as confident but ready for anything.

"We're not taking them lightly and we can't go in there with the attitude we had against Boston College," he said. "We're just going to be ready to play no matter what."

Sherrill said the Aggies need to play with more consistency and less sloppiness, especially in the area of turnovers. Texas A&M committed four turnovers against Boston College while compiling 422 yards in offense.

"If we do the same thing we did two weeks ago on offense, and we're more consistent, then we'll score some points," he said. Standouts for the Mavericks include tailback Randy Johnson, who gained 710 yards last season and scored eight touchdowns.

The UTA offensive line could be its strength, as 270-pound right tackle Bruce Collie and 245-pound left guard Danny Stout lead the blockers for the Mavs' two quarterbacks.

Elliott says the Mavs, who won the Southland Conference title last year with a 6-5 (4-1 in the conference) record, have an excellent chance to repeat that performance.

"I think that winning the conference has given us a confident attitude," he said. "The fact that

we got over the hump and won the games that we needed to win was a big plus.

"In the past, it seemed like we managed to get beat in that one key game and because of the past year's success, we will probably be a more confident football team."
