line," he said. "They heard all the noise coming from the stands and lost their concentration."

Even though the Movin' Mavs had to settle for a field goal on that drive, they did move the ball 79 yards against the Aggies — a sign of hope for Elliott.

"I'm pleased with Danny Jackson (Maverick quarterback)," he said. "He showed me he can move the football for us. They played more odd defensive fronts than we expected, but Jackson still did a good job. I think their secondary still has some problems because we were able to pass on them a lot."

Maverick quarterbacks completed 20 of 37 passes for 242 yards against the Aggies but only threw 11 times in the first half. Caldwell said UTA should

have passed more against the Aggie secondary.

"They didn't show us too much defense against the run when we saw the film of the Boston College game, so our game plan was to run right at them, but when we saw we couldn't do that we should have passed more," he said. "We just got caught up in the running game."

In their season-opening 63-10 victory over Sam Houston State, the Mavs had 543 yards in offense, including 251 in the air on seven completions. Caldwell rushed eight times for 118 yards during that game.

While the Aggies host the Louisiana Tech Bulldogs Saturday in Kyle Field, the Mavs open their Southland Conference schedule at Northeast Louisiana. UTA will host the Bulldogs in Arlington's Maverick Stadium Oct. 2.

OSU's vengeance drops Aggies to second place

The Oklahoma State University Cowgirls had to wait four months and 13 innings for revenge, but the wait was worth it.

The Cowgirls ambushed the Texas Aggies in the finals of the UTA Invitational Softball tournament to take first place and settle their score.

In May, the Aggies defeated OSU in the final game of the AIAW College World Series to win the national championship.

This time, however, the Cowgirls were able to sneak past Texas A&M in a tournament that was not for the weak of arm.

The Aggies played eight games in two days — three Friday and five Saturday — and won six of them.

But the two they lost were both to OSU, enabling the Cowgirls to win the latest round of what is quickly becoming one of the most competitive rivalries in college softball.

The Aggies began play on Friday against Oklahoma City University, winning 3-0 on a Shan McDonald one-hitter.

They defeated Nebraska 1-0, scoring the only run in the first inning. With one out, Cindy Foster tripled and scored when Patti Holthaus singled. Lori Stoll gave up two hits while striking out 13 batters.

In the first round of double elimination play, the Aggies defeated Baylor 1-0. McDonald struck out nine and gave up one hit.

In Saturday's first game, she pitched her second no-hitter the year against Sam Houston State as the Aggies won 14-0. McDonald struck out 11. The Aggies scored in the eighth inning when Iva Jackson singled and Josie Carter tripled.

The Aggies then lost to OSU 4-2 to put themselves in the loser's bracket. After beating Oklahoma University, the Aggies defeated OSU 5-0 to force a final game showdown.

The game was scoreless after the regulation nine innings, as neither team could score in the 10th, 11th or 12th innings.

But in the bottom of the 13th, OSU pushed across its only run with the help of three singles and a Texas A&M error.

McDonald struck out 15 Cowgirls and held OSU to six hits, but the tired Aggies couldn't muster a productive offensive attack.

Texas A&M travels to Arlington again Tuesday to play a double-header against UTA.
