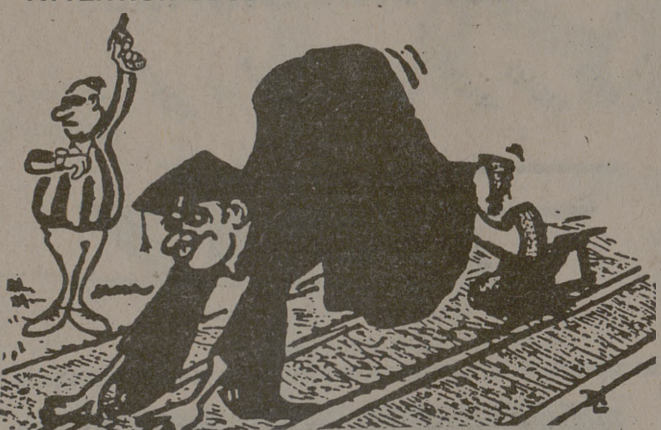

## German to join Spacelab

United Press International HUNTSVILLE, Ala. — National Aeronautics and Space Administration announced Monday that a West German will become the first foreigner to travel into orbit in a U.S. shuttle. Next year he will join Americans on the first Spacelab mission.

Ulf Merbold, a native Greiz, West Germany, won over Wubbo Ockels of Netherlands for the spot.

Also named to the flight is Byron K. Lichtenberg, an American engineer from Massachusetts Institute of Technology.

Spacelab, a 23-foot-long laboratory, will be launched into space in the shuttle's cargo hold. Unlike America's old Skylab, Spacelab will always remain in the shuttle and will not be in space unattended.

The laboratory, packed with 38 devices that will be used to conduct 71 experiments, was built by the European Space Agency and was given to NASA. The space agency is buying a second unit.

Merbold and Lichtenberg will join four astronauts on the shuttle set for Sept. 30, 1982.

The pilot is scheduled to be shuttle veteran John W. Young, who commanded the real space shuttle's first mission.

Co-pilot will be Brewster Shaw Jr., who has yet to fly in space. The mission specialist selected are Robert A. Parazak, a space rookie, and Owen K. Garriot, a veteran of a Skylab mission.

The flight currently is scheduled for seven days, but NASA is considering extending the mission to 10 to 11 days, adding an extra set of hydrogen and oxygen tanks to the shuttle's fuel-cell power generators.

Merbold will be the first American to fly on a U.S. space shuttle. Two Soviet cosmonauts visited an American space shuttle in orbit in 1975, but did not actually fly into space aboard the American spacecraft.
