Abortion: war vow by NOW

INDIANAPOLIS — The feminist movement will take the offensive against attempts by the far right and Roman Catholic Church hierarchy to outlaw abortion, delegates to the National Organization for Women convention vowed.
Some 1,800 delegates attending the annual convention approved a resolution Sunday requiring their leadership "to develop

comprehensive electoral strategy to defeat right and other anti-women's voters."

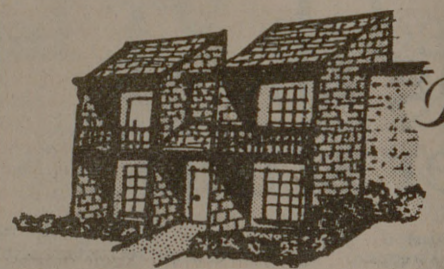
The resolution would "continue to expose the role of the Roman Catholic Church hierarchy in the abortion and anti-birth control movement."
"The right wing is attempting to repress the victory in the inductive rights of Americans by foisting upon us their primary views of the place women should have in society," the resolution said.

"We know the presence is hostile to the women," Bridget Whelan, risburg, Pa., said. "I don't believe we should be in the hands of giving the right wing an opportunity to hand us a big defeat."

Judy Goldsmith, who elected NOW president in Dec. 1, said the organization would not renew its drive for Equal Rights Amendment if the enemies of feminism moved from office. She said the right wing is the enemy is "the right wing of Reagan administration," especially Sen. Jesse Helms, N.C.

Goldsmith said NOW will strive to become one of the strongest political action groups in the nation. NOW has two national PACs and PACs on the state and local level.

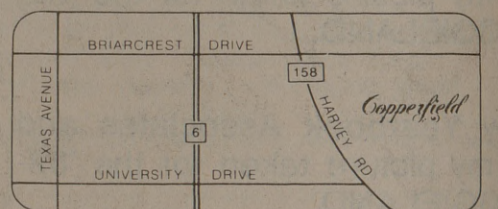
