lead over the Red Raiders and letting a 17-7 second-quarter lead over the Cougars slip away.
But Teaff said the Bears aren't using season records or offense to predict the game's outcome. And he said they're going to be watching Gary Kubiak, Jimmy Hector and Earnest Jackson with a great deal of interest.
"Obviously, A&M's most exciting, strongest point is their passing game," Teaff said. "I have tremendous respect for Gary (Kubiak). He's one of the outstanding quarterbacks in the nation this year."
"I've always been very impressed with Hector and Jackson. Their being out during those games really hurt A&M a lot. It's too bad their almost at all strength now."
Kubiak enters the game having completed 110 of 192 passes for 1,183 yards and 10 touchdowns for a 237-yard average. Four of his receivers have caught 76 straight passes for over 100 yards: Don Jones, 19 for 223 yards; Jimmy Teal, 14 for 189 yards; Hector, 19 for 162 yards; and Jimmie Williams, three for 33 yards.

Although Texas A&M defense, which has given up 416 yards a game thus far, has been criticized, Teaff said he sees the Aggies' talent in that area.
"I was very impressed with the A&M defense against Houston," he said. "When you look at the game film, you really can't tell that Houston won the game."
Teaff's weapons on offense and defense include split end Gerald McNeil, wing back Bruce Davis, running back Alfred Anderson and defensive end Charles Benson.

"Benson's one of the best defensive players I've ever coached," Teaff said.
Texas A&M last defeated Baylor in 1977 by a score of 38-31. During the last four seasons, the Aggies have lost 24-6, 17-7, 46-7 and 19-17.
None of the Aggie players know what to expect from the Bears. But they agree that they don't want to lose to Baylor for the fifth year in a row.
"Baylor's a team that I'd really like to beat, and the whole team's really up to beat them because we haven't beaten them in four

years," weakside linebacker Jeff Fuller said.
"Baylor has a very good quarterback and some real fast receivers in (Bruce) Davis and (Gerald) McNeil. We plan to contain them, but they've got good backs, too. They have a balanced offensive attack, so we really have to be aggressive

against them. We'll have to play just as good or better than we played against Houston."
Ray Childress, who's been moved back to his defensive tackle spot after spending the last two games at left end, said the Bears can attack from several angles.
"Baylor's going to run at us

and throw on us, too," he said, "so you really can't single out any one strength that they have. I would imagine they're going to throw on us a good bit, because they've got those two great receivers."
Middle linebacker Jerry Bullitt said the Aggies must play with intensity to be able to defeat

Baylor.
"We'll have to make fewer mistakes and play a more aggressive game," Bullitt said.
"Baylor has a real good offense and they'll be hard to stop. Their offensive line is great. I guess it'll be a battle of the lines."
