Egyptair jet crash-lands on wet Swiss runway

United Press International GENEVA, Switzerland — An Egyptain Boeing 707 jetliner skidded off a wet runway and broke into flames on landing at Geneva's Cointrin airport Sunday, injuring one woman passenger, airport officials said. An airport statement said the 174 passengers and crew on board were evacuated, a woman sustaining slight injuries after she jumped from the craft.
