

# DeLorean may be released from prison, lawyer says

**LOS ANGELES** — Automaker John DeLorean soon may be bailed out of prison, but the millionaire jet-setter — a "colossal bail risk" — will be monitored closely by federal agents and his travel will be restricted severely.

DeLorean's attorney said he reached an agreement Tuesday with federal prosecutors on securing his client's \$5 million bail which will allow the former General Motors whiz kid to be released from Terminal Island federal prison.

"I expect he'll be out in a day or two," famed criminal attorney Joseph Ball said after a meeting with DeLorean, who has spent eight days behind bars since his arrest for allegedly trying to arrange a \$24 million cocaine deal to save his failing sports car company.

Prosecutors, who said they would seek a federal grand jury indictment in the case no later than Friday, did not confirm that DeLorean soon will be released from custody.

Chief Assistant U.S. Attorney Alexander Williams said he was concerned that DeLorean may flee after posting bail.

"We expressed our concern in court last week," he said. "We

termed him a 'colossal bail risk.'"

DeLorean must put up \$250,000 cash and the remainder in collateral from his 48-acre estate in San Diego's plush Pauma Valley to win his release from prison.

If the entrepreneur makes bail, his passport will be revoked and his travel restricted to New York — where he resides with his family — and a large area of Southern California.

"Interestingly, the travel restriction does not include the eastern district of New York, where all the airports are," Williams said.

The silver-haired DeLorean, arrested last week by FBI agents, will also be under intense supervision by the Pretrial Services Agency, which will require personally check a probation officer twice a week, spokesman Mike Melzer said.

While DeLorean has been confined at Terminal Island, Northern Ireland car company that prosecutors said he had allegedly tried to secure with DeLorean in cocaine and heroin fits declared bankrupt in a day in Detroit.

DeLorean has been in court five days ago.
