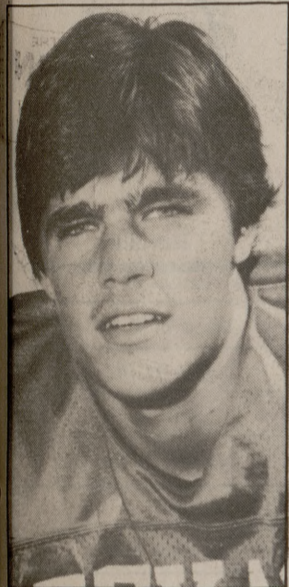
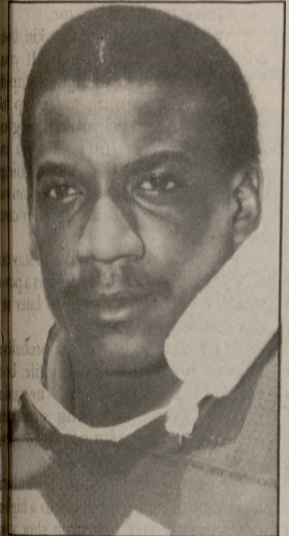


# UH-Texas game crucial



Robert Brewer leads Texas against Cougars in Austin

Here are notes on Saturday's Southwest Conference games, with full-season and league records in parentheses:

**HOUSTON (3-4-1, 2-2-1 in SWC) at TEXAS (4-2, 2-1 in SWC), 1 p.m.** — Longhorns and Cougars only teams left with mathematical chance to beat SMU out of title — or with more realistic hope of sharing with Mustangs and/or Arkansas. Texas defense played one of season's outstanding games last week in 27-0 victory over Tech, while Houston offense led 31-27 decision over TCU as Lionel Wilson became first UH QB to rush for more than 1,000 yards in his career, and went over 1,000 passing for season. Texas QB Robert Brewer also busy in win over Tech, breaking season TD drought with three scoring runs. Darryl Clark remains Texas' leading rusher and No. 2 in SWC with 85.8 yards per game. Offenses about equal, Texas gaining 384.7 yards per game to Houston's 381.7. Texas defense third in SWC at 278.2 yards a game, Houston fifth at 332.9. Teams are one-two in SWC pass defense, Texas yielding 126.5 yards per game and Houston 144.6, as 'Horns cope with No. 1 SWC pass receiver David Roberson (39 catches for 544 yards). Cougars haven't won in Houston against Longhorns, losing one at Rice Stadium, one at Astro-dome and tying two years ago. Texas holds 3-2-1 SWC series lead, all-time 4-2-2 advantage. Cougars' 30-0 victory in 1976 one of only two shutouts against Texas in last 119 starts.

**TEXAS TECH (3-5, 2-3 in SWC) at TCU (3-5, 2-3 in SWC), 2 p.m.** — Both are 3-5 for season, 2-3 in SWC and played to 39-39 tie last year in one of wildest SWC games ever. Red Raiders took 32-9 third-quarter lead last year before TCU rallied for highest-scoring tie in SWC history. Each team had five TDs, but TCU tied on blocked punt that produced safety in final minutes. Stanley Washington, now SWC's No. 4 pass receiver (3.4 per game), was shut out in first half last year but had nine catches for 156 yards in second half. His two fourth-quarter TD catches in 1980, the last one for 82 yards with 1:44 left, overcame a 17-0 Tech lead to win for Frogs, 24-17. TCU improved offensively this year, Tech defensively: Frogs averaging 332.6 yards per game, Raiders fourth in SWC defense with yield of 331.7 yards a game. Tech has scored three TDs in last four starts, but defense sparked two weeks ago in 10-3 loss to then-No. 1 Washington. Frogs were first SWC team to play Raiders, scoring 28-16 win in '82, Tech's second season. TCU holds 19-17-2 series lead, 13-6 Fort Worth lead. Tech leads SWC series by 11-9-2 after winning six straight from '73 through '78. Last Tech win came in '78 as teams tied in '79 and '81.

**ARKANSAS (7-0, 4-0 in SWC) at BAYLOR (2-5-1, 1-3-1 in SWC), 2 p.m.** — Coach Lou Holtz's Razorbacks came back from 6-0 down in third quarter last week to win seventh straight, 24-6 over Rice, and held fourth place in UPI poll. Hogs' 7-0 start is best since 1969. Arkansas turning in best SWC rushing-defense numbers in 19 seasons — yield of 73.4 yards per game best since '65 Hogs allowed 74.9. Hog defense has also allowed only three TDs, one by rushing, to pace nation in scoring defense and hasn't allowed a TD in four SWC games. Hog offense (403.1 yards a game) and defense (225.7) are best in SWC, while Baylor ranks sixth in both offense (317.7) and defense (357.9). Baylor's Alfred Anderson No. 5 SWC rusher (79.1 yards a game), Gerald McNeil No. 2 receiver (4.5 catches per game), while Darryl Bowles (71.1 yards) paces strong Razorback ground game. Series has been one of SWC's most hectic in recent years, Arkansas' 41-39 victory last year marking second-highest losing score ever by a SWC team. Razorbacks hold 30-28-2 lead in third-closest all-time series in SWC. Razorbacks also hold 29-26-2 SWC series lead. Baylor has 16-10-2 advantage in Waco, 42-15 victory two years ago ending Arkansas run of six victories and two ties in Waco.

**SMU (8-0, 5-0 in SWC) at RICE (0-8, 0-5 in SWC), 2 p.m.** — Sixty-second meeting sends winless Rice against SMU team ranked third by UPI after 47-9 win over Texas A&M last week. Mustangs lead the series, 36-24-1, hold 17-12-1 advantage in Houston and have won five straight from Owls. SMU offense adjusting to stacked defenses by passing for nine TDs in last three games and 12 of 31 TDs for season. QB Lance McIlhenny has moved to No. 1 in SWC pass efficiency with high national rating of 147.2 points. Meanwhile, Eric Dickerson is closing in on SWC career and season rushing marks, needing 292 and 426, respectively, to break each. SMU tailback is No. 2 national rusher with 164.9 yards per game as SMU leads SWC rushing (287.9 yards per game) and is second in total offense (391.1 yards). Mustang defense second in SWC (267.7 yards per game). Rice defense yields 191 rushing yards per game, 193 passing. Owl attack under QB lead of soph Doug Johnson last three games. Teams combine

to boast eight of SWC 10 individual leaders — SMU's Dickerson in rushing, tandem and scoring, McIlhenny in passing, Craig James in punting, Wes Hopkins in interceptions, Rice's Vince Courville in kickoff returns and Melvin Robinson in punt returns.

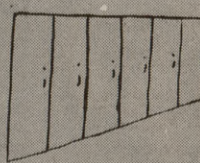
