Texas may acquire reins of Matagorda

United Press International AUSTIN — Charles Travis, the director of the Texas Parks and Wildlife Department, said he would ask the Legislature for \$800,000 to manage the federally owned portion of Matagorda Island should Texas acquire managerial control of the land. That is what Travis estimates it would cost to manage the federal wildlife refuge and adjacent wetlands on the 43,893 acres during the fiscal years 1984-85. The Texas Parks and Wildlife Commission voted Wednesday to give Chairman Perry Bass the authority to sign a proposed

agreement between the U.S. Interior Department and the state of Texas. Gov. Bill Clements has asked the federal government to surrender management of 19,000 acres of the land on the barrier island near Corpus Christi to the Texas Parks and Wildlife Department. An environmental impact statement prepared jointly by the Interior Department and the General Services Administration calls for the management transfer, but before it can be made, the Interior Department's U.S. Fish and Wildlife

Service, the Texas General Office and the Texas game must sign an agreement. The proposal is opposed by conservationists who fear over-development of the barrier island, which has been the winter home for the endangered whooping crane. The federal government would retain ownership of 19,000 acres under the proposal, but the state would manage and 24,893 acres of state lands to be included in the national wildlife refuge system.

Efforts put Ecuadorian girl in Dallas for costly surgery

United Press International DALLAS — A former Peace Corps worker's three-year effort has brought a handicapped girl from Ecuador to Dallas, where she is scheduled to receive costly surgery she couldn't get at home. Phyllis Dodd and Marjory de Lourdes Vega Chavez, 9, shared a tearful reunion Wednesday at

the Dallas-Fort Worth Regional Airport.

Dodd met Marjory while teaching in Ecuador on a Peace Corps program. The child is afflicted by a congenital bowel disorder that has kept her from

attending school. "She was such a lively, able girl," said Dodd. "She entered school but because her problems the teacher her not to come back."

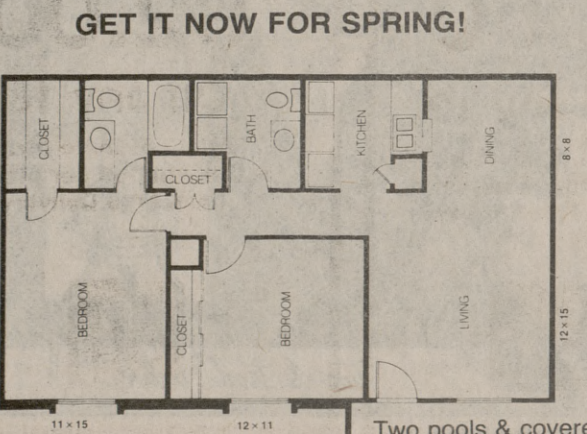
