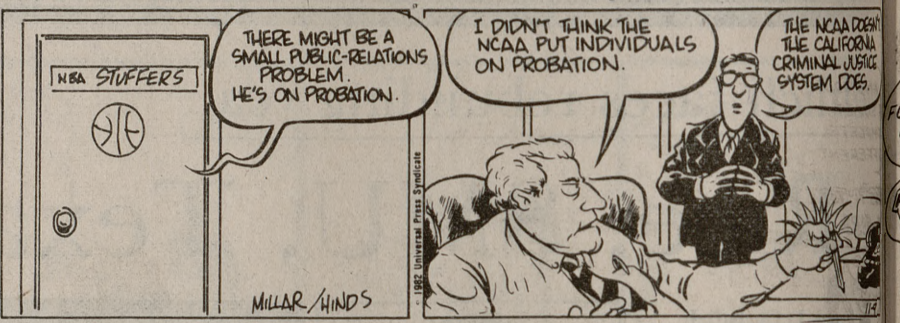

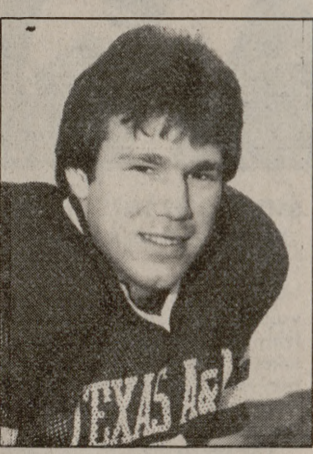

Elkins probable QB for Arkansas contest

With only days remaining until the Aggies play the Arkansas Razorbacks in Little Rock's War Memorial Stadium, Texas A&M coach Jackie Sherrill says quarterback Gary Kubiak's injury outlook is a "day-to-day" situation.

Kubiak, who sustained a chip fracture in his left ankle and a severely sprained hip against SMU Oct. 30, has not worked out since the injuries. Sophomore John Elkins, who took over for Kubiak in the Aggies' 47-9 loss to the Mustangs, is listed as the starter for Saturday's game, which starts at 7 p.m.

With Kubiak's limited mobility as a result of his ankle injury, Sherrill said, it'll be more difficult for the senior quarterback to protect himself.

"I won't play Kubiak unless he's able to protect himself," Sherrill said at Monday's weekly press conference in Cain Hall. "It's the worst position you can get in when you can't protect yourself."

The Aggies enter the game with a 4-4 season record and a 2-3 Southwest Conference record while the Razorbacks are 7-1 and 4-1 after Saturday's 24-17 loss to the Baylor Bears. Arkansas coach Lou Holtz expressed concern Monday about the response of the ninth-ranked Razorbacks to their first loss of the season.

"I don't know how we'll respond," said Holtz. "But I know how they had better respond."

Holtz credited Baylor, saying the Bears controlled the line of scrimmage in their homecoming upset of Arkansas.

"There were periods we played awfully well, especially on defense in the first and third

quarters," Holtz said. "On offense we didn't play nearly well after we lost (Gar Anderson and (Jessie) Clark Anderson and Clark, along with cornerback Nathan Jones and defensive end Ron Frazier missed practice Monday because of injuries from the Baylor game."

Holtz said quarterback Taylor started against Baylor because of the strong wind at Waco and Baylor's quick pass rush. He said Taylor's strong arm and quick release on passes were the deciding factors.

But he noted Taylor injured an ankle against Baylor and Jones threw better in Monday practice than he did last week. Holtz said this week's practice would determine which quarterback will start against the Aggies.

Sherrill cited Arkansas offensive linemen Steve Korte, Ted Mohammed and Jay Beatty for their leadership and ability.

"Arkansas is a play-action passing team and they're going to pass protect well," he said. "That's what Baylor did Saturday against them."
