Oh, come all ye madrigals

Let the trumpets sound. Bring on Lord and Lady Raleigh's court. Let the feast and the festivities begin.

An of holiday entertainment and dining will be held at the 2nd annual MSC Madrigal Dinners on Dec. 3, 4, 5 and 9, 10, 11.

"We're taking you back in history to a banquet of the Renaissance-Medieval days," said Patti Fleitas, artistic coordinator of the Madrigal Dinners.

The madrigals include 10 singers who escort the Lord and Lady of the court into the hall, which was transformed from the Memorial Student Center Ballroom into a medieval stone manor.

The audience are considered the royal guests. When they ar-

rive, they proceed through a market, where merchants are selling woven products and pottery.

Then the court jester shows the guests to the dining room.

"The banquet will include all the processions and the fanfares of those days, with a historical reality becoming a modern fantasy," Fleitas said.

The procession will then pass by a wassail toast, a boar's head procession, and a flaming pudding ceremony. These processions were characteristic of banquets in the Medieval-Renaissance period, as guests were taken through each course of the meal.

The wassail toast is a holiday drink often used to toast someone's health. The boar's head ceremony is the main part of the

Christmas feast and the flaming pudding is the dessert.

During dinner, guests are entertained by strolling minstrel singers, jugglers and magicians. The entertainers at the MSC Madrigal Dinners create an atmosphere similar to the one in medieval days, Fleitas said. This atmosphere includes the costumes, whose designs range from the Gothic to the Renaissance period.

The evening ends with a Christmas concert by the madrigal singers. The first two parts deal with the birth of Jesus and the shepherds who leave their flock to see the baby Jesus. The last part tells how Christmas became what it is today.
