Voodoo

DALLAS — Officials investigating reports that a County Community Commission Department supervisor employed to help in "magic dust" in a meeting and scatter a broken egg a creek — voodoo practitioners tended to confuse commission.

work ethic
strongest

AUSTIN — The work ethic is stronger in the South than in any other region of the United States, two university researchers say.

Dr. Norval Glenn, a University of Texas sociology professor and Dr. Charles N. Weaver, Mary's University management professor, said the stereotype of the Southern worker as shiftless and lacking ambition is all wrong.

The researchers said their findings are especially important as "more managers of companies consider relocating to Sunbelt."

Glenn and Weaver used data from seven national surveys conducted from 1955 to 1980 and answers to questions distributed between 1974 and 1980 by the National Opinion Research Center at the University of Chicago.

For the study, the South included Texas, Delaware, Maryland, West Virginia, Virginia, North Carolina, South Carolina, Georgia, Florida, Kentucky, Tennessee, Alabama, Mississippi, Arkansas, Oklahoma and Louisiana.

Roughly 70 percent of Southerners and non-Southerners said they would continue to work even if they had enough money to live comfortably the rest of their lives.

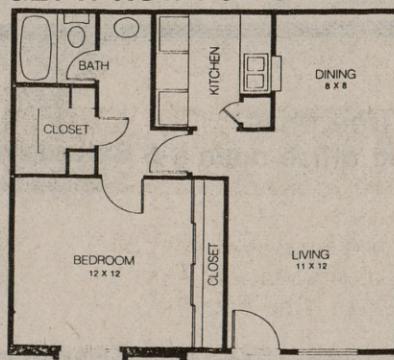
