Texas is top turkey

WASHINGTON — Texas has the most place names containing the word "turkey," a government Thanksgiving computer search of place names showed. Texas' tally of 174 far outdistanced Kentucky's 94.

Of seven words associated with the Thanksgiving holiday used in the search by the U.S. Geological Survey, a unit of the Department of Interior, geographers found turkey to be the most popular name. Other words checked included Thanksgiving, pilgrim, Mayflower, cranberry, pumpkin and Plymouth.

"Turkey" turned up in 1,684 different place names, followed by pilgrim with 487 names and cranberry with 357. There are 129 Plymouth and 74 Mayflower place names in the nation. Thanksgiving was the least used name. It appeared in only nine places in the country, three of them in Alaska.

Among the more exotic names found in the directory are Pilgrim Wash Well in Mohave County, Ariz., Left Turkeytoe Branch and Right Turkeytoe Branch in Pike County, Ky., Rotten Pumpkin Pond in Nantucket County, Mass., Turkeywoman Gulch in Lake County, Mont., and Hog Walkway Cranberry Bogs, a swamp in Burlington County, N.J.

A close second in the festival film competition is a Mack Sennett-style approach to tips on ski safety, "The Ski Dummies," which employs the talents of two acrobatic skiers and clowns from Munich, West Germany.
