Dallas commissioners look for lost ballots

United Press International DALLAS — Faced with pleas from Democrats and black civic leaders calling for the ousting of Dallas County Elections Administrator Conny Drake, the commissioners court tonight planned an inquiry to determine why several voting precincts ran out of ballots in the Nov. 2 election. At least 28 of the county's 400 voting precincts - most of them in Democratic and minority areas - ran short of ballots in the election, the first major test of the county's new punch-card voting system.

The commisioners also will investigate why 58 ballots mysteriously appeared on an elections department worker's desk 16
