

### Houston, Razorback pace perfect evening

 Not one of the four games involving Southwest Conference teams went as expected Wednesday night, but all of the SWC clubs won.

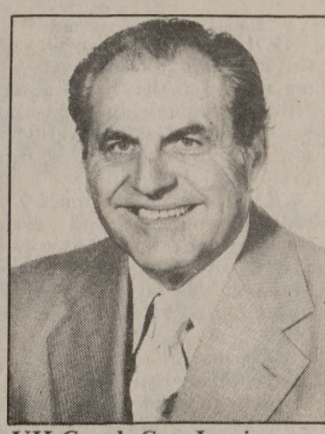
Both the Houston Cougars and Arkansas Razorbacks, who were supposed to win, did so. But neither of those victories was of the easy variety.

And neither SMU nor Baylor was expected to come away with victories. But they did.

The perfect evening for the SWC ran the conference's early inter-sectional record to 15-7 with all of the Wednesday-night winners keeping perfect seasons going.

Eleventh-ranked Houston managed to win its third game, 74-65 over Mississippi State, but looked less than impressive doing it. Arkansas, meanwhile, had to overcome a surprising halftime deficit to whip Texas-San Antonio, 78-59.

Baylor and SMU won their games by a point — the Bears holding off several scoring attempts in the final minute to defeat Alabama-Birmingham, 56-55, and the Mustangs getting

team rolled to two impressive victories in the season-opening Kettle Classic. "We were flat, flat. I'm not taking anything away from Mississippi State. They are not a bad team. They are a well-coached team."

"I was a lot more worried about this game than I was the two games. I will tell you now, if we come out like we did tonight at Biscayne Bay, Houston plays Saturday night we will lose."

Arkansas, after struggling throughout the first half, pulled itself behind Texas-San Antonio at intermission, 31-29. But Razorbacks improved their performance defensively and scored the Roadrunners' first 13 minutes of the second period, 33-10.

"The win didn't come as a surprise," Arkansas coach Eddie Sowell said. "I thought we played well in the first half, but we couldn't get the ball in the basket."

Wright's winning free throw against Centenary came at a foul that Centenary coaches should have been charged against Wright.

He made the front end of one-and-one opportunity then, after he missed the second free throw, a Centenary player knocked the rebound out of bounds.

SMU had to overcome a point deficit early in the second half and did so chiefly on shooting of Dave Piehler Larry Davis.

Baylor scored its victory points with a tip-in by Jay Shaker gave the Bears a three-point lead. Then, after Alabama-Birmingham narrowed the deficit to one with 1:44 to go, Blazers missed three chances to go in front.

Baylor thus beat a team that defeated both Virginia and Indiana in last season's NCAA tournament.


