

"Had Ron Love been properly managed, had the control of Ron Love been left to someone other than Ron Love," said attorney Robert Wales, "that day (of the shootings) would never have happened.

Love was committed to Rusk State Hospital after the shootings. Prosecutors have attempted to try him on murder charges, but he has been found incompetent to stand trial three times and is in jail in El Paso awaiting a fourth competency hearing.
