NEW YORK — Computer activities can be worthwhile for children, says Leona Schaub, research director for an organization that designs computer software for children.

Schaub says computer activities as young as 3, 4, 5 years of age can help them with variables, get feedback in some cases, help them do their own learning experiments.

The Children's Computer Workshop executive director is not suggesting children substitute computer play with blocks or playing cards or reading books.

"Early experiences with new technology can help children feel comfortable with she adds. "(Children) are already learning. They know they're going to do some things with and that's all right. Adults come to computers for the time worry about doing wrong" or even breaking machine.

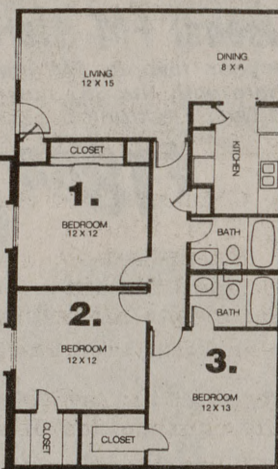
