

Regulatory Commission staff report made public Monday exonerates Houston Lighting & Power Co. of complaints it mishand-

led a controversial report on the South Texas Nuclear Project. A 500-page NRC staff report said HL&P and its new design engineeer, Bechtel Power Corp., have "adequately resolved or dispositioned" all construction and engineering ques-

tions raised by Quadrex. "All items (in the report) important to plant safety had re-ceived adequate and timely attention," the NRC report said.

The study by a California based consulting firm hired by HL&P said Brown & Root Inc. engineering design work on the \$5.5 billion plant — much of which was done as the project was being built - was inept. A few months after receiving

the report, HL&P fired Brown Critics complained HL&P did not supply the NRC com-plete copies of the report until

several weeks after receiving it and charged HL&P was trying to hide the report.
