## Seizures usual in heart implant

**SALT LAKE CITY** — About one in every 20 patients undergoing heart transplant or artificial heart implant operations will develop seizures within a week of their surgery, to a University of Utah medical expert said Tuesday.

University doctors thought their post-operative treatment of artificial heart patient Barney Clark may have caused his seizures on the fifth day following the Dec. 2 implant operation of the world's first permanent man-made heart.

But, Dr. Chase Peterson, university vice president for health services, says the general and localized seizures Clark suffered Dec. 7 are apparently a relatively common risk all implant patients face.

"We were worried at first that it could be a stroke or hemorrhage or clots from the heart or something due to his recovery from kidney failure and all the metabolic things that were going on during that period of instability (following the implant operation)," Peterson said.

But Peterson said, "We've ruled out the hemorrhage, and we've ruled out the clots. However, we are still left with the possibility of the unstable metabolic condition."

In an effort to improve the flow of blood to Clark's lungs, kidneys and other major organs, Utah doctors set the man-made heart to give Clark the blood pressure of a 20-year-old.

They also hoped the improved circulation would flush wastes from his body and reduce the buildup of fluids in his legs and feet. But the loss of fluids also drastically changed Clark's body chemistry, especially his potassium levels.

However, Peterson said Dr. William DeVries, who performed the implant operation, "in discussing this case with three heart transplant centers around the country, has learned from them that about 5 percent of their patients who have undergone cardiac transplants

have had seizures three to five days after the procedure." He said doctors at the University of Utah also "blow-dried" the brain to prevent a dramatic change in the flow of blood to the brain resulting in seizures. This is "because the new hearts these transplants had, like Dr. Clark's, were delivered without blood to the brain's blood vessels."

"Since the heart transplants had been ruled out also — Dr. Clark was a patient — the vessels in the brain were not prepared to receive the flow of blood and some overreacted, and go into spasm," Peterson said. "They (the other doctors) were very interested in what we were learning about Dr. Clark's case, cause they've never been able to adjust their cardiac output to respond to this hypothesis as we are."

"So we're sharing our space with them, and they're seven times the size of us," Peterson said.

"But it would (the doctor) is terrifically sick right now, good pumping. This man has been related to the seizure case, as the transplanters think it may be related to seizures that they are getting in the same time period."

The 62-year-old transplantist had apparently fully recovered from his seizure by Jan. 8, and the Utah doctor considered sending Clark home by the end of January.

But then he suffered a persistent nose bleed two days and his recovery was delayed. Doctors were forced to clamp on Clark Jan. 18 to clamp on arteries in his left chest, ending the bleeding problem.

Clark remained in serious condition Wednesday with his recovery being set by three weeks. Peterson said the bleeding never threatened Clark's life, but administration posed a "significant" delay in his scheduled release.

be slowed down by reducing fruit's oxygen intake, it ripens more slowly and less spoilage will occur."

Reported to be tasteless, nontoxic, TAL Prolong powder made of sugar, cellulose and glycerides. The powder is dipped in a solution of powder mixed with water, which blocks the tiny openings in the skin. Made in Britain, the product works on bananas, papayas and pears.
