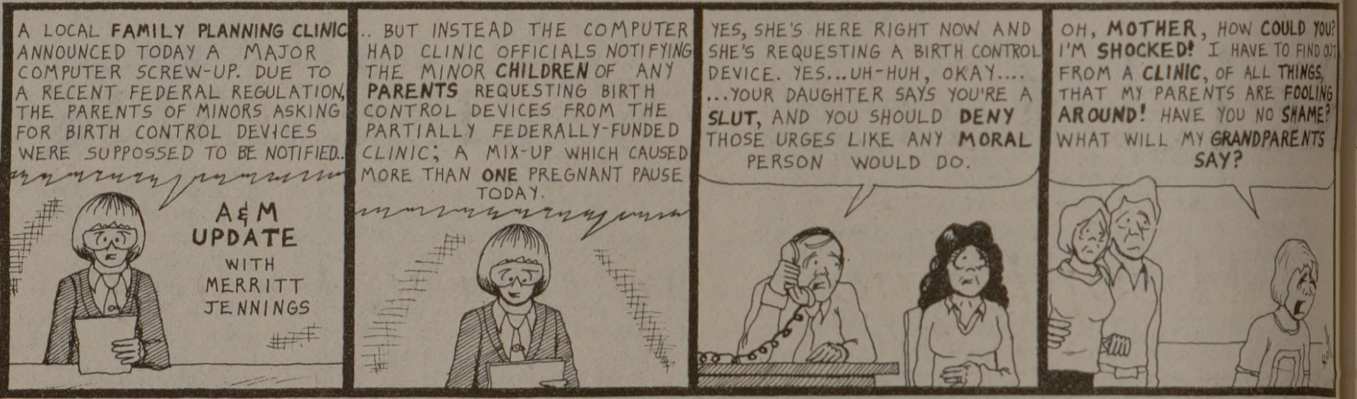

Two men charged in giant U.S. theft

NEW YORK — A guard who told police he had been handcuffed during an \$11 million armored car company robbery and an accounting student described as the guard's associate, were charged in the largest cash theft in U.S. history.

The FBI said it was looking for at least two other suspects in the Dec. 12 theft from the Sentry Armored Car Courier Corp. FBI officials said they hoped to recover "most or all of the cash."

Christos Potamitis, 24, of Queens, arrested Wednesday on a vacation in San Juan, Puerto Rico, was the only guard on duty at the time of the heist.

George Legakis, 21, of Brooklyn, an accounting major at Wagner College on Staten Island, was an associate of Potamitis, said Lee Laster, assistant director of the FBI in New York.

Legakis was arrested Tuesday in New York. Both were charged with bank larceny.

Potamitis was arrested at a Holiday Inn in San Juan where he was vacationing.

Legakis, who worked as a part-time cook at his father's Queens diner, was arrested Tuesday night at FBI headquarters in New York.

The suspect, a Canadian who has lived in New York for years, was arraigned in U.S. District Court in Manhattan Wednesday and held on \$1 million bail. A hearing was set for Feb. 14.

Assistant U.S. Attorney Block said in court that on the night of the theft, a woman watching from her window in the building through an elevator door operated from the patcher's office where Potamitis was supposedly watching television.

Smoker ulcers found less than non-smokers

BOSTON — According to a seven-nation survey, non-smokers are three times more likely to have painful ulcers of the colon than are smokers, but doctors warned against taking up smoking to prevent the disease.

The results of interviews of more than 70,000 people conducted by the Boston Collaborative Drug Surveillance Program were published Thursday in the New England Journal of Medicine.

According to the study, the risk was even lower in men and heavy smokers than in women and light smokers.

There was no difference found in the number of cases of the disease among nonsmokers compared to former smokers.

Doctors refused, however, to say nicotine actually protects a person from developing ulcerative colitis, painful ulcers of the colon characterized by bloody diarrhea.

Even if smoking helps reduce the risk, there is much stronger evidence smoking contributes to other diseases "that are more common and more lethal than ulcerative colitis," said an accompanying editorial.

"I see no possibility whatsoever that the overwhelming balance against tobacco would be overcome," wrote Dr. John C. Bail III.

He said there were thousands of possible explanations for findings, many of which are as implausible as "the notion that cigarette smoking prevents the disease."
