# Baylor, Falwell clash over Baptist support

**United Press International WACO** — The chancellor at Baylor University has criticized Moral Majority leader Jerry Falwell for suggesting that Southern Baptists withdraw their support from Baylor and other colleges because they no longer represent conservative Baptist views.

"Falwell is obviously completely ignorant of Baylor University," said Abner V. McCall, Baylor chancellor.

"Baylor is more in the mainstream of Southern Baptists than Jerry Falwell," McCall said Wednesday.

Falwell, in remarks made Tuesday in Fort Worth, said Baptist colleges and universities have strayed too far from fundamental Baptist doctrine.

He said severing ties would help end the struggle between conservatives and moderates within the Southern Baptist Convention.

"I think that rather than fighting and feuding going right now and the wrestling power, the churches ought dissolve connections with the schools that no longer support them theologically," Falwell said.

Falwell, a television evangelist and president of Moral Majority, is pastor of the Third Road (Independent) Baptist Church in Lynchburg, Va.

# Con's kin attacks attorney

**United Press International HOUSTON** — With months experience as a Harris County prosecutor, David Mitcham apparently sent many men to jail that he did not place the convict who brother attacked him in an apartment and beat his friend Monday evening.

David Mitcham, 32, on Wednesday he had just returned home when two men, one brandishing a knife and the other a knife, walked through his unlocked bedroom.

"They said, 'Be cool, cool,'" Mitcham said of the attack. "One commented, 'It is what you get for sending brother up, David.'"

Mitcham said he has prosecuted 15 felony trials and estimates he has sent "scores" of men to prison through plea bargaining. He said he had never to whom the man was referring.

"It was a prosecutor's nightmare," Mitcham said.

He said the two men forced him to lie face down on a pillow in his bedroom. They put a pistol, knife and a 20-gauge shotgun he keeps for protection against his neck.

His girlfriend ran to the door and screamed for help, Mitcham said. Then she was caught, beaten and choked, and the two men talked of raping her. She screamed alerted a landlady upstairs. The landlady grabbed her own pistol, came downstairs and ordered the men out.

Mitcham said the incident likely will make him "more paranoid," but added, "You're not as a prosecutor that this with the territory."
