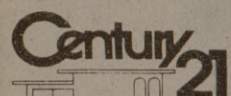

'Italian Playboy' convicted in fraud and bigamy case

United Press International PHOENIX — It took only 94 minutes for jurors to convict Giovanni Vigliotto, the man who wore a ring inscribed "Always alone," but who married 105 women during worldwide exploits and swindled at least one of them out of her life savings.

Vigliotto frowned slightly when the verdict was read Tuesday. His stoic behavior was a sharp contrast to his conduct during the six-week trial.

At one point, Vigliotto burst into tears and fled from the stand when questioned about his

family, who allegedly was tortured by Nazis.

"I feel terrific," prosecutor Dave Stoller said after the verdict was read.

Patricia Gardiner, 43, the Mesa, Ariz., real-estate agent who accused Vigliotto of abandoning her penniless after their marriage, smiled and exclaimed, "Both counts!" Vigliotto was convicted of bigamy and fraud in his marriage to Gardiner.

Superior Court Judge Rufus Coulter ordered the panel, with

courthouse today. It was speculated the jury would have to consider Vigliotto's prior convictions involving transportation of a stolen vehicle and transportation of stolen securities.

Vigliotto's attorney, public defender Richard Steiner, said earlier Vigliotto could receive a maximum of 34 years in prison if the prior convictions were considered.

In his opening arguments in the trial, Steiner described Vigliotto as an Italian playboy.

"This defendant is in love with life, in love with women and

in love with marriage," Steiner said. "He created an aura of excitement that allowed the women to join in his fantasies offered to these 100 or so women a chance to withdraw from the humdrum of life."

Gardiner testified Vigliotto vanished two weeks after Nov. 16, 1981 marriage, absconding with \$36,500 of cash and possessions.

"I realized I'd been victimized and my prince had turned into a frog," she told the jury.

Vigliotto described himself as a nice step, but Stoller's jury in closing arguments, state contends, bigamy is something this man does perpetrate a fraud.

"To use marriage this way, I think, despicable. He got from these people their money. That is the greatest shame."
