According to testimony, Ritter sold a new house in 1977 to a home buyers, ruling builders who give warranties on houses couple who resold it three months later to Vijai Gupta.

The homebuilder was sued by Gupta, who claimed a faulty foundation caused the walls to crack, the roof to leak and the patio to separate from the rest of

In a concurring opinion, Justice Franklin Spears said latent defects in a house are unlikely to be noticed until after the original owner has sold the house.

'In our very mobile society, a builder-seller should know a house he builds might be resold within a very short period of time; therefore, our extension of the implied warranty should not place any extra burdens on other defendants. builders," he wrote.


