

United Press International LAS VEGAS, Nev. — Police bomb squads, besieged by threats since the discovery of dynamite at three casinos, concentrated Wednesday on sear-ching the evacuated University of Nevada campus — the target of three threats.

Police Tuesday ordered the evacuation of the 10,000-student university and searched the 360-acre campus.
Hundreds of students who

live on campus were moved to a motel, and the university's 24hour, student-operated radio station, KUNV-FM, was shut down. University President Dr.
