## Wheaties fight set for court

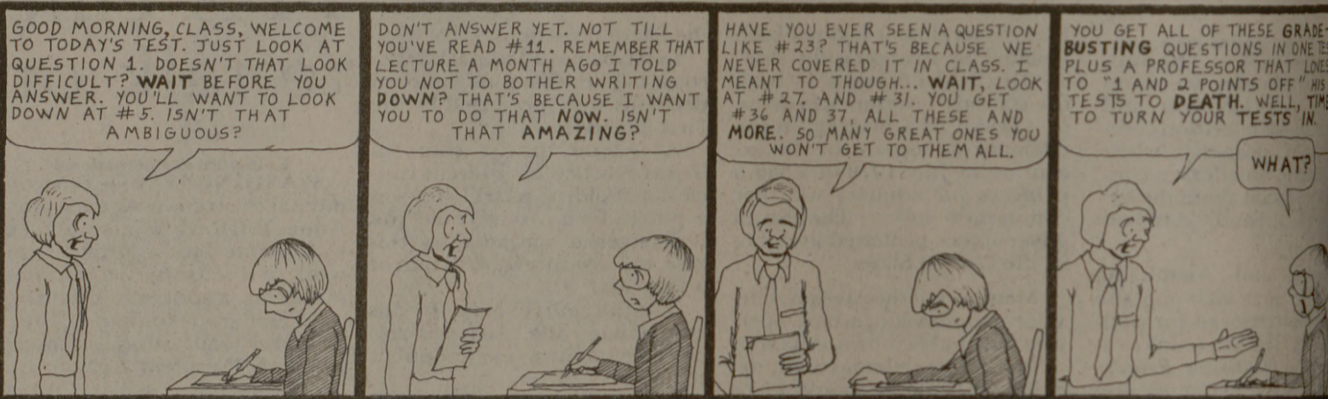

## Louisiana holds hearing

# Nuclear waste site opposed

**United Press International NEW ORLEANS** — Louisiana has the right to veto any plans to store nuclear waste within its boundaries, and state officials want to make sure the federal government knows it.

The Department of Energy

set a public hearing Monday in New Orleans to solicit comments on proposed guidelines to be used in selecting the nation's first permanent storage site for radioactive waste. One of the five finalists in site choice is in Deaf Smith County, Texas.

DOE spokesman Jack Siegel said the hearing was not intended to focus on the actual selection of a site. But Louisiana officials said their testimony attempted to ensure the state does not get selected for a dump it does not want.

In 1978, Louisiana lawmakers agreed to allow federal testing in the Vacherie salt dome on the Webster-Bienville Parish line in exchange for an agreement allowing the state to veto locating a dump in those salt

mines. "We still feel the 1978 agreement will be maintained," said Dr. L. Hall Bohlinger, a member of the state Department of Natural Resources who will participate in the hearings.

Bohlinger said state officials want to make sure the Nuclear Waste Policy Act — passed by Congress in December and signed by President Reagan in January — does not destroy the agreement Louisiana has with the federal government.

The bill includes language allowing states or Indian tribes

to veto any federal decision where depositories are proposed but a joint resolution of Congress, signed by the president, could overturn that veto.

DOE officials have named the five finalists for a dump site are Gibson Dam, 10 miles east of Canyonlands National Park in Utah; a basin in Hanford, Wash.; volcanic near Las Vegas; salt flat in Texas county; and a salt dome in Richton, Miss.

One of those sites selected by the president in 1987.

## '61 Klan attack costs a million

**United Press International KALAMAZOO** — A federal judge Monday ruled a Freedom Rider beaten by Ku Klux Klansmen in Alabama 22 years ago is entitled to \$1 million in damages from the federal government.

U.S. District Judge Richard Enslin ruled in favor of Walter Bergman, 84, a civil rights activist who claimed the beating led to a condition that left him confined to a wheelchair for life.

Enslin said Bergman won his case by default because the government disobeyed the judge's order to release suppressed documents sought by Berg-

man's attorney.

Bergman claimed the government and the FBI were negligent because they knew there would be violence when the Freedom Riders arrived in Anniston, Birmingham, Ala., but failed to render protective action.

Bergman was among a group of Freedom Riders who were arrested in Alabama in 1961 to test compliance with Supreme Court segregation rulings.

According to testimony in trial, Bergman and others were attacked by a Klan mob as the bus arrived at the Anniston depot on May 14, 1961.
