Now Torture tale only 1 of 3, says cop

United Press International DALLAS — A man gave police three different stories before finally admitting he had seen an acquaintance run from the scene of an officer's shooting, a New Orleans homicide detective testified.

Stephen Farrar, one of seven New Orleans policemen accused of violating the civil rights of witnesses in November 1980, testified Monday that he never saw Robert Davis beaten by any

Davis, however, told an entirely different story last week when he testified he was forced to go downtown and was tortured for several hours until he talked. Davis said the informa-

The trial, which continues today with the testimony of defendant Dale Bonura, Farrar's partner, concerns the days following the shooting death of patrolman Gregory Neupert in the poor Algiers section of the city.

Farrar, 31, told defense cocounsel Ralph Whalen he and Bonura sought out Davis the night of Nov. 11 after an anonymous telephone caller said Davis might know something about Neupert's death.
