# China lures junketeers

United Press International WASHINGTON — Members of Congress are using their Easter recess to take off on trips around the globe, with China apparently the most popular junket stop. At least 30 members of Con-

gress are visiting China this week. Europe and South America will have a few visitors.

Some members of Congress, possibly concerned about their constituents' views of such travels, prefer not to announce such plans in advance, so their junkets become known only accidentally or through expense reports.

Speaker Thomas O'Neill, D-Mass., and 14 other House members are in China this week 'to meet with a number of highlevel officials," O'Neill's office said.

Several spouses and staff members are also on the trip. Rep. John Dingell, D-Mich., and chairman of the House

Energy and Commerce Committee, is leading a 10-member delegation to Japan, China and Hong Kong to discuss trade, energy development, internacommunications and issues, Dingell's health






