

The light Galveston turnout showed 2,727 in favor of the resolution, and 2,356 against.

In San Antonio, Henry Cisneros, 35, won a second two-year term by beating five candi-dates with 94 percent of the

Cisneros won his term by the largest margin since the mayoral election of 1929 when the winner got 97 percent of the vote. runoff in that race.

Cisneros was elected 55,397 votes. None of his fire opponents — including a menber of the Socialist Workers Party and another whose campaign headquarters was in a public telephone booth — had votent
