## Union leaders protest anti-drug campaign

United Press International DALLAS — A tough anti-drug program instituted by builders to check widespread drug use by construction workers and rising accident rates has been condemned by union leaders critical of surprise searches and blacklisting.

The American Civil Liberties Union has called a board meeting to discuss a possible protest of the program by the Dallas chapter of the Associated Gen-

eral Contractors which union leaders say amounts to "Gestapo tactics."

Those participating in the anti-drug campaign will be taught how to re-word their company policies so workers can be searched or required to undergo blood or urine tests.

"The workers don't have to submit to a search but they become an ex-employee if they don't," said Jim Sprague, safety-director for the builders group.

Union leaders acknowledge the existence of the drug problem among workers but said they object to the searches or tests.

Guada Lueck, spokesman for the contractors, said that the construction work uses drugs and that as much as \$15 billion in accidents and property damage is a result of drug use on the job.

## Teacher loses latest appeal, claims fired for communism

United Press International HOUSTON — A math teacher lost the latest round of appeals to get reinstated to her post when a Houston school committee rejected her argument she was fired because she was a communist.

Instead the panel said she was fired because she did not follow

orders and falsified information.

"It was already pre-decided," said Carolyn Eubanks, Monday. "When the jury is chosen by the administration that has recommended to terminate you, it is a joke to call it an appeal hearing."

She said she will now appeal to the Houston district's board of trustees and, in the mean-

time, continue to teach at Elementary School.

Under district rules, teachers can keep their jobs while the appeal process is continuing.

The five-member Hearing Committee unanimously upheld the school district's recommendation to fire Eubanks after eight hours of testimony.

## Mistrial ruled in death case

United Press International HOUSTON — A woman accused of plotting the death of defense lawyer Percy Foreman will have to stand trial again on the charges.

State District Judge Doug Shaver said Monday discovery of a tape recording of a secret meeting between defendant Susan Parrish, 40, and a private detective working for the police made it impossible for Parrish to receive a fair trial and ordered a mistrial.

Shaver said he had listened to the tape and found it devastating to lawyer Craig Washington's defense the woman had been entrapped by overzealous detectives anxious for an arrest.

"In other words, the defendant is saying through it (the tape) she did plan and commission the offense. It's rather clear," Shaver said.

He said he ruled the mistrial because "the defense was not given what they were supposed to be given. Then, they cannot prepare a defense consistent with the recordings that the state was going to use against them."

Prosecutors contend Parrish, the ex-wife of a millionaire oilman, sought revenge against the 80-year-old Foreman — her divorce lawyer in 1978. Prosecutors said she was angered because she thought Foreman had

"sold her out" in the divorce. Shaver said Parrish would be retried. A trial date was not set immediately.

Washington said he would move to have Parrish released on bond. She has been jailed since her arrest last year during a meeting with an undercover detective in which she gave him \$2,000 for truth serum and poison.

At the time of her arrest, Parrish was on probation on a conviction for trying to run over her ex-husband with her Cadillac.
