



George Schultz blasts PLO

WASHINGTON — Secretary of State George Shultz says the needs of the Palestinian people would be better served by stripping the Palestine Liberation Organization of its reponsibility to represent them.

In a news conference Tuesday, Shultz blamed the setback in Middle East peace talks on the PLO and urged the Arab world to reconsider its 1974 decison to make the PLO the sole representative of the Palestinian people.
The PLO, Shultz said, has

Referring to the decision of the PLO not to exercise its responsibility to enter the negotiations through Hussein, Shultz said, "We have a saying around here: 'Use it or lose it




