Smith advises professors extra careful when talking to students in their office ways to leave the office open.
"I just would not set me to be put in a compromising situation," Smith said.
Of all reported cases, cent involve male students harassing female students. Some cases involve female professors male students and professors and male students.
The affirmative action cannot take any action case of a bisexual professor harasses students of both sexes.
Bisexual activity is prohibited under federal law because it is not discriminatory.
A student harassed in a case still may sue the university.
The initial reaction of students is disbelief. They do not understand what happened. The students to question themselves why what they may have done encourage it, what they were wearing.
"How could I have been stupid? I've heard that every person I've talked to said, 'How could I have been dumb as to not figure out he was going to go on and walked into office and the door?'"
"It's not (the student) it's a problem of power harassment occurs in the place and also in faculty relations where one person power over another."
The harasser tries to put the student on a pedestal in a situation where they must go along with what he will harm them in grades, salaries and conditions.
