United Press International tion community facility, WASHINGTON — Rural and waste disposal loan congressmen blame years of indifference for the weakening of the Farmers Home Administration — the Agriculture Depart-ment agency that lends money to farmers unable to obtain credit elsewhere.

A 16-page report by the Con-gressional Rural Caucus says neglect has forced the agency to operate under policies that are unable to improve the weak farm economy.

"The Farmers Home Adminstration has been subjected to years of indifference by the Executive Branch in its recommendations to the Congress," the report says

"The Department of Agricul-ture has been part and parcel of this indifference, orchestrated by an Office of Management and Budget which has exercised the foresight of the so-called Modoc bird, not looking ahead, but where it has been.

In its report, the Democraticcontrolled caucus criticizes the Reagan administration for failing to implement existing rural development laws in the manner Congress intended to have them implemented. Instead, the caucus says, the administration has tried to "curtail, decrease and terminate workable programs.

The report singles out recent administration budget propos-als that recommend consolidating existing Farmers Home administration Administration rural housing grants, subsidies and other programs into a single rural housing block grant prog-

ram to the states for complaint. The document also criticizes another block grant proposal, which calls for consolidation of the Farmers Home Administra-


