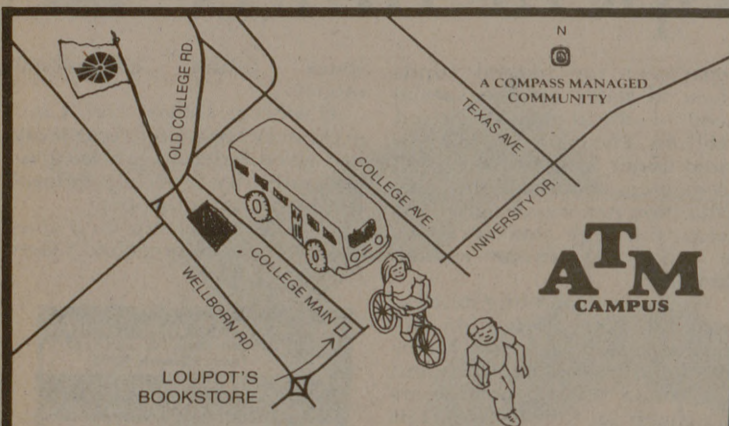

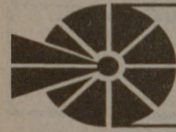

Suspects return, charged

WASHINGTON — Two men linked to the Capitol Hill investigation, who took names and hid in Australia for months, are back in the States and in jail on \$500,000 bail each.
 The arrest of the two men in April reportedly launched a federal and congressional investigation into possible drug and money laundering activities. No member of Congress has been charged in the investigation, which is continuing.

The pair, Troy Todd and Douglas Marshall, pleaded innocent to charges during a hearing day in a U.S. District Court a day after they returned to the United States from Australia where they unsuccessfully sought extradition.
 "They picked the hearing point away from Washington, D.C.," Assistant U.S. Attorney Daniel Bernstein said. "They can't get farther away from court than Perth, Australia."

The two men left the States before their indictment last November. When indicted, a federal judge ordered each a \$1 million bond.
 At Monday's hearing, government attorneys urged U.S. District Judge Mas Hogan to raise the \$1.5 million each. Hogan said \$500,000 for each man was sufficient.
 Bernstein said there were no charges against the men. He was trying to avoid extradition and had no plans to return to the United States to face charges against them.

Last week, Robert Yeshmer House employee, was indicted to one year in prison allegedly conspiring with Ronald Dellums, D-Calif., an aide to obtain cocaine marijuana. Dellums has been indicted for any wrongdoing.
 At a hearing on the Yeshmer case, Bernstein said Yeshmer's link between the Marshall conspiracy and Hill.
 But at the latest hearing, Bernstein's lawyer, Chris noted the indictment of Todd and Marshall had no references to any indictments at Capitol Hill.
