AUSTIN — Former Vice President Walter Mondale roared out of step with the American people.

Mondale criticized Reagan for slashing taxpayer funding for education at the worst possible time and leading "a retreat away from sound program education."

"Our future requires more than a new, profound commitment to education," he said. "What I am proposing is not a federal program to be imposed, but a partnership at levels."

Mondale promised to indicate the details of his partnership and charged the president with disregarding "human development as part of the nation's objectives."

Mondale promised to create substantially increased funding for education and search if he were elected president. However, he declined to endorse a tax increase to increase teacher salaries which he labeled as the "core of education revitalization."

Saying that every dollar invested by the federal government in education generates a sixfold return in the Gross National Product, Mondale said that the nation's economy and educational system are hinged on education.
