Texas A&M's Vanne Akagi gets all-SWC tennis honors

DALLAS — Texas A&M's Vanne Akagi was chosen to the all-Southwest Conference women's tennis team in voting by SWC coaches Monday. Southwest Conference singles champions Rodney Harmon of SMU joined Houston's Margaret Redfeard and SMU's Stephanie Fess as most valuable men and women tennis players. Harmon and Redfeard won the No. 1 singles championships Sunday at the SWC tournament in Corpus Christi, Texas.

Harmon and Texas' Johnny Levine, whom Harmon defeated Sunday in the No. 1 singles final, were unanimous selections to the men's all-conference team. Also chosen were David Pate of TCU, Eric Korita of SMU, Peter Doohan of

Arkansas, Tres Cushing of Rice and Kelly Evernden of Arkansas. Cushing and Evernden tied for the sixth spot.

Doohan and Pat Serret were unanimous all-conference in doubles voting. They were joined on the team by Korita and Jerome Vanier of SMU and the TCU team of Pate and Corey Wittenberg. Redfeard and SMU's Fess drew unanimous backing on the women's all-conference team.

The doubles teams are Kelli Chase and Beth Wagner of Arkansas in a unanimous selection, Kirsten McKeen and Jane Johansen of Texas, and Redfeard and Joy Tacon of Houston. SMU coach Dennis Ralston was named SWC Coach of the Year.

Who was that man who blanked the World Series champions Monday night?

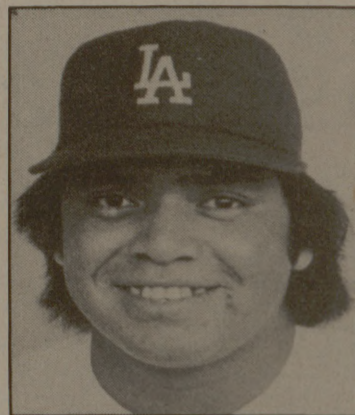

"Once he gets the lead, he just wants to stay ahead of the hitter and not walk anybody. He did that and they made the plays behind him."

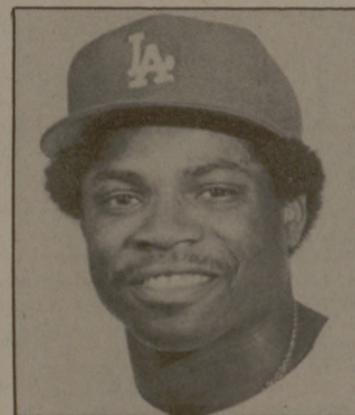
And who were those guys driving in half the Dodgers' runs?

They were newcomers Mike Marshall and Greg Brock, who are working on becoming the latest heroes in Los Angeles. Marshall hit his first home run of the year, a two-run shot, and Brock drove in two runs with a single and double.

"Those two youngsters are trying so hard and they want to do the job so bad," said Dodgers' Manager Tom Lasorda. "We just have to keep them relaxed and let their ability do the work

rather than their minds."

Marshall's two-run shot in the fifth broke up a scoreless duel between Valenzuela, 3-1, and Joaquin Andujar and was the first of three Los Angeles home runs. Guerrero and Dusty Baker also connected off Andujar to help the Dodgers extend their winning streak to three games.

Guidry, 2-1, struck out three and walked one in his second complete game this season. Minnesota starter Frank Viola took the loss.

The Twins scored in the fourth inning, when Gary Wash hit his third home run of the year into the left-field wall. The only other hits off Guidry were singles in the third and eighth by Lenny Faedo.

Spurs, Nuggets ready for ABA reunion in conference semifinal

SAN ANTONIO — A reunion of sorts begins tonight for many in the Denver Nuggets' organization, but don't expect that to make them soft on their NBA quarterfinals opponents — the San Antonio Spurs.

Tonight's best-of-seven series opener is the first time two former American Basketball Association teams will face each other in an NBA playoff.

Among the cast of characters in this game is Denver coach Doug Moe, who was fired by San Antonio three seasons ago in the midst of an off year that followed the Spurs' 1979 appearance in the NBA semifinals.

Moe's Nuggets were upset winners over Phoenix in their three-game miniseries that ended Sunday night, thanks to some last-second heroics by guard Mike Evans, who used to play for — you guessed it — San Antonio.

Evans hit a three-point shot with 36 seconds to go in regulation that sent the Denver-Phoenix game into overtime Sunday night. He then hit two straight buckets in the extra period — one of them following a steal — to break open the contest.

HOUSTON — In a hectic day of basketball recruiting two Southwest Conference schools added big names to the list of recruits committed to play basketball.

At Houston, basketball coach Guy Lewis said the Cougars completed their recruiting Monday with the signing of Worth High School center Greg Anderson.
