## National income up

WASHINGTON — The per capita personal income of Americans rose slightly less than their cost of living last year, going up 5.3 percent to \$11,056, the Commerce Department reports.

In 15 states, however, mostly in the Northeast, the increase was more than the national figure, the department's bureau of economic analysis reported Sunday.

State per capita personal income, said the report, ranged from \$15,200 in Alaska to \$7,792 in Mississippi.

Although the national income figure rose by 5.3 percent, an adjusted figure showed an increase of 5.9 percent in cost of living.

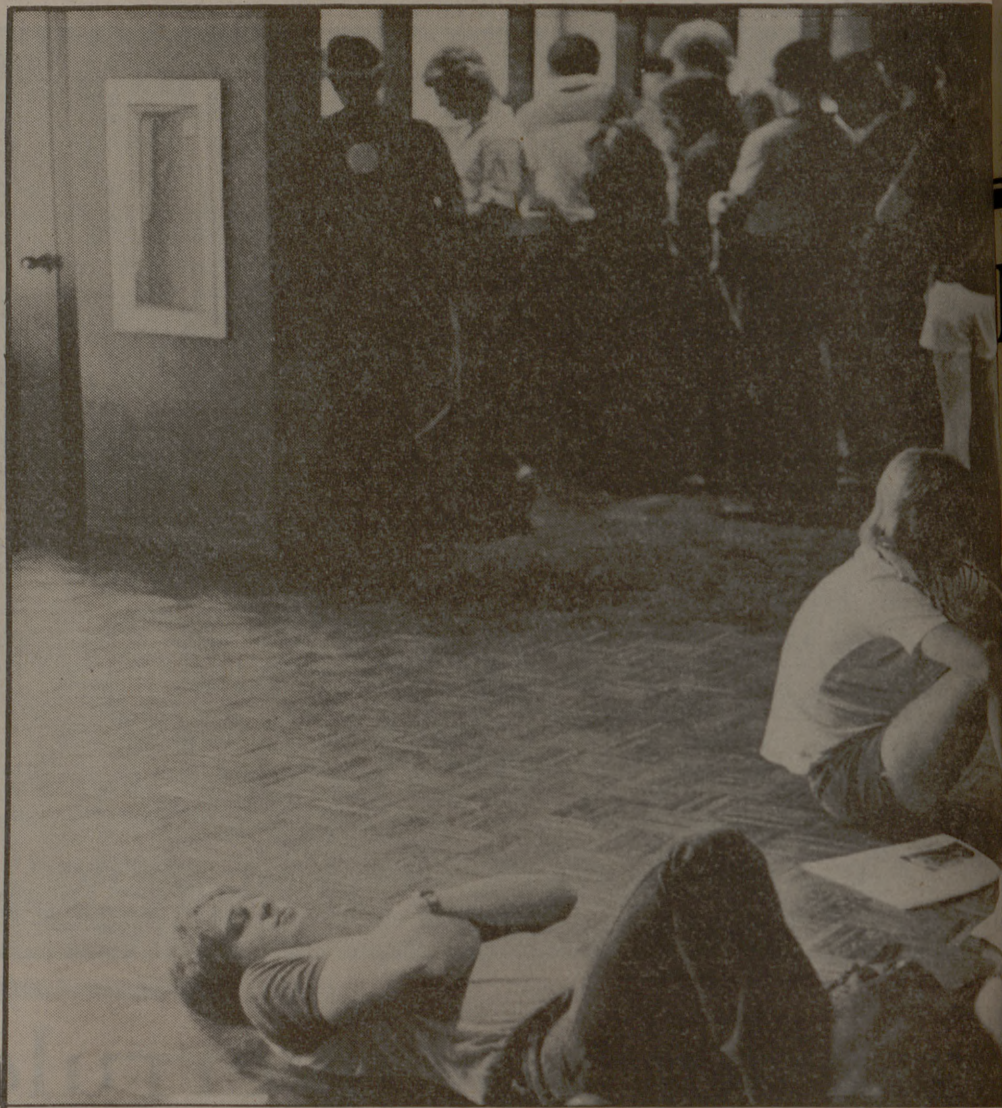

## EPA asked for remedy to home contamination

WASHINGTON — A woman who believes her teenage daughter has rheumatoid arthritis because they live above an abandoned asbestos mine Monday urged a House subcommittee to pressure the Environmental Protection Agency for a remedy.  
Catherine Scott told the Energy and Commerce oversight and investigations subcommittee, "The EPA has probably reduced us all to some statistic."

Scott lives at the Mountain View Mobile Home Estates in Globe, Ariz., site of an abandoned asbestos mine.  
That site and another called Tar Creek in Oklahoma — ranked in 1981 as the nation's worst hazardous waste site — are the subject of a hearing on the EPA's lack of progress in cleaning them up.  
Sen. Dennis Deconcini, D-Ariz., blasted the environmental agency for inaction.  
"I've been appalled at the dis-

regard of EPA for the health and welfare of citizens in the state," Deconcini said.  
He echoed the attitude Rep. John Dingell, D-Mich., chairman of both the Energy and Commerce Committee and its oversight subcommittee. Dingell said chrysotile asbestos fibers were found in the substation's waste water treatment tank in 1979 and there is evidence EPA may have known even earlier.  
Dingell also criticized the Justice Department for failure to act on two EPA requests to take legal action.  
Scott said she used all her savings to make a down payment on a home in the subdivision in 1979. Ten months later the health department said she was exposed to asbestos contamination that could cause disease and cancer.  
She is especially worried about her daughter Stacy, 18, who has had one ailment after another in the last year, including arthritis.  
Three top EPA officials were scheduled to testify Monday at the subcommittee's hearing into the agency's handling of the \$1.6 billion "Superfund" program designed to help pay for cleanup of hazardous waste sites.
