As originally drafted, the bill would have banned alcoholic be-verages from the passenger compartment of a motor vehicle, not just consumption by the

Marinelle Timmons, the state director of Mothers Against Drunk Drivers, lauded the bill approved by the subcommittee as a "step forward," but express ed reservations that the bill might not go far enough.

"If the driver is riding alone, we've got him," she said. "If there's a passenger, I have no doubt the driver will hand the beer to him.

"We would have like to have seen alcoholic beverages banned in the passenger compartment. But the law does say basically that we don't condone drinking while driving, and that's the attitude that we're trying to get across in the state.
